Greetings from the University of Bergen!

We are pleased to announce that we are now accepting nominations for Spring 2025.

#### **Online nomination**

You nominate your students in our online nomination portal, <u>Nomination web</u>. **Deadline: 1 October.** We do not accept nominations by email.

#### **How to access Nomination web**

- Username: The email address we have sent this email to (use small letters only).
- Password: Order a password at the login page the first time you log in or if you need a new password.

Our **Fact sheet** for the academic year of 2024/2025 and more information for exchange partners is available at our website for partners.

### **Student applications**

- Students must apply in our online application system, <u>Søknadsweb</u>, by **15 October**.
- The nominated students will receive a confirmation email (cc to nominator) approximately 30 minutes after you have added the nomination. The email will describe the application procedures.
- Required documents: Passport/national ID card, Transcript of records, Proof of financing (only citizens from countries outside EU/EFTA). <u>Additional documents</u> for students to some faculties.
- Students must have completed 60 ECTS prior to the exchange semester.

### **Courses**

- The course list for 2024/2025 is <u>available online</u>.
- Students may in addition to courses within the subject area of the agreement, choose courses from other departments (preferably within the same faculty).
- Please note that for restricted courses with a limited number of places, students nominated on an exchange agreement in the relevant subject area will be prioritized. Earth Science and Biological Sciences have very limited capacity.
- Subject areas only open for exchange students when specified in the exchange agreement: Medicine, Dentistry, Fine Art, Design, Music and Performance/Composition.

#### **English Language Requirements**

- Students are required to have a minimum level B2 (CEFR) in English. We consider your nomination of the student as confirmation of language proficiency, and do not require any English test to be submitted.
- **Exception**: Students who apply for courses in English Language and Literature must have a minimum of level C1 (CEFR). They must document their language proficiency by <u>submitting a test</u>.

## **Student housing**

- Exchange students are guaranteed <u>student housing</u> through the Student Welfare Organization (Sammen) if they apply in <u>Sammen's application portal</u> within the application period **1 October 1 November**.
- The students will be offered housing shortly after the deadline and should accept the offer, even if their admission at UiB is still under consideration.
- Shared rooms will be allocated to short term students (1 semester stay).

• Students who will not be coming to UiB must <u>cancel the tenancy agreement</u> within **30 November**. Cancellations after the deadline are treated as an ordinary termination period, meaning that students may only terminate their agreement 3 months after the start of the tenancy, with 3 months' notice.

#### **Students with special needs**

- Students with special needs can get <u>special arrangements and assistance</u> from UiB during their exchange period.
- Please notify <a href="mailto:incoming@uib.no">incoming@uib.no</a> by the nomination deadline to make sure that we can meet the specific needs of your students.
- Sammen can offer rooms/apartments that are specially adapted for students with special needs. The students must apply through <u>Sammen's application portal</u> during the period **1 October 1 November**..
- Requests for disability-related accommodations are considered on a case-by-case basis and availability.
   Supporting documentation (medical certificate), must be submitted to SAMMEN. Please note that students are not guaranteed a disability adapted room/single room even if medical certificate is provided.

## **Learning Agreement (for Erasmus+ Partners)**

- Learning Agreements will be signed **after** the students have registered for courses. Course registration starts on **16 December.**
